Pitchfork Ranch Horse Sale Doctoring Rules

One or two man doctoring. Contestants in two-man doctoring will receive half the points.

One-man Doctoring

- 1. 3:00 min to head; 6-minute total. Time starts when competitor crosses line/calf number read.
- 2. Time stops when rope is removed from calf or time is up.
- 3. 2 shot limit to rope calf. Must be either head, half head, or head with a leg.
- 4. 3 attempt limit to lay calf down.
- 5. Calf must remain on the ground when you step off your horse to remove rope.

All scoring left to judges discretion with emphasis on horsemanship, stockmanship and rope management.

Disqualifications for tying hard and fast, scattering cattle while running, jerking cattle down, running cattle into fence, or lost rope

Two-man Doctoring

- 1. 2:30 min to head; 4:30 min total. Time starts when competitor crosses line/calf number read.
- 2. Time stops when two front feet and two hind feet are strung and calf is then released.
- 3. 2 shot limit to rope calf. Head loop must be either head, half head, or head with a leg.
- 4. One non-sale horse is allowed to assist, scoring will be based off of sale horse only.

All scoring left to judges discretion with emphasis on horsemanship, stockmanship and rope management. Stepping off sale horse to string feet will constitute a higher score.

Disqualifications for tying hard and fast, scattering cattle while running, jerking cattle down, running cattle into fence, or lost rope
